## Greater New Hope Baptist Church Officers' History

New Hope Baptist Mission was established on November 23, 1933, by Rev. Chester L. Smallwood. Rev. Smallwood was appointed Pastor and eighteen officers were elected. Rev. Smallwood served as the pastor from 1933 until 1937, followed by Rev. Charles H. Hamilton.

In 1938 Rev. Charles H. Hamilton became the pastor of New Hope Baptist Mission. In 1953 under Rev. Hamilton's pastorship, the church was renamed Greater New Hope Baptist Church. Because of Rev. Hamilton's vision and insight, the church moved from 5<sup>th</sup> Street, NW, downtown to its present location 816 8<sup>th</sup> Street, NW, Washington, DC. Rev. Charles H. Hamilton served as the pastor from 1938 until 1982.

In 1985 Pastor Melvin G. Brown became the Pastor of Greater New Hope Baptist Church. Thanks be to God, he is still our present shepherd, and was consecrated to Bishop Melvin G. Brown in April 2009.

Each Pastor spiritually led and guided the church congregation with Christian love and dedication.

The History of the Church Board of Deaconess is as follows:

## Secretarial Staff

Along with the Deacons, Trustees and Treasurer, in 1933 Catherine Holmes was selected as the Church's first Secretary. She functioned as the total secretarial staff and performed her duties exceptional, dutiful, and faithful. As the church membership grew, the need to expand the secretarial staff became apparent.

Currently, Greater New Hope Baptist Church, under Bishop Brown's guidance, the Secretarial Staff consist of the Church Secretary, Michelle Waters, and the Corresponding Secretary, Lovie Hawkins. When needed others have volunteered to assist the Church and Corresponding Secretaries.
