In 1935 Sister Dean was elected to the office of President in which she served until 1992. Brother George Irick was elected President in 1993, with Sister Jaynell Iverson as First Vice President. Sister Wilhelmina Abner was elected Vice President in December 1996, and in 2008 was elected to the office of President, with Brother George Irick serving as Vice President.
